PRE-OP AND POST-OP INSTRUCTIONS for surgeries performed at Hospitals or Surgery Centers

1-2 Weeks before Surgery:

- 1. Pre-op appointment at our office
- 2 If surgery is scheduled at a hospital, pre-admits are required. You will be mailed/given instructions on how to complete.
- 3. If surgery is scheduled at Health Care Partners Surgery Center, pre-ops are required at the surgery center. You will be
- mailed/given their information to call and schedule this.

Day Before Surgery - see type of anesthesia for your instructions

- ____General Anesthesia for Adults nothing to eat or drink after midnight (8 hours prior to surgery time) Children - will receive special instructions.
- ____Local with MAC Sedation Nothing to eat or drink after midnight (or 8 hours prior to surgery time)
- ____ Local Injection only Eat a light meal prior to surgery

Day of Surgery

If surgery scheduled at a HOSPITAL: You must arrive 2 hours before your surgery. (this is a hospital requirement) If surgery is scheduled at a SURGERY CENTER : Arrive 1 ½ hours before your surgery

<mark>DO ...</mark>

- 1. Arrange transportation to and from surgery as you will not be able to drive after surgery bus or taxi is *not* acceptable. Bring the name & phone # of the person transporting you. (*ONLY Local Injection is exempt*)
- 2. ... have a responsible adult at home to care for you the first 24 hours.
- 3. ... STOP SMOKING.
- 4. ... stay in the area after surgery (within 30-45 minute travel time to office).
- 5. ... bring your current list of medications and all supplements to your pre-op visit.
- 6. ... call the office if you become ill prior to your surgery date.
- 7. ... arrange for transportation to and from office for post-operative visit (within 1-6 days).
- 8. ... shower & shampoo the night before or morning of surgery. Do not use any lotion or powders.
- 9. ... take your regular medications, unless otherwise instructed. *If taking diabetic medication or high blood pressure medication, get instructions from our office about taking these meds before and after surgery.*
- 10. ... bring your insurance card to all appointments. Notify office of any change in insurance plan immediately.

DO NOT ...

- 1. <u>DO NOT take aspirin</u> or aspirin-containing products, supplements, herbs including green tea that increase bleeding 2 weeks prior to or after surgery.
- 2. DO NOT drink alcohol for 2 weeks before surgery and 6 weeks after surgery.
- 3. DO NOT over-expose your skin to the sun, 2 weeks prior to or after surgery.
- 4. DO NOT get a perm, cut, or tint 2 weeks before or 4 weeks after surgery when having a facelift or forehead lift.
- 5. DO NOT plan a dental cleaning appointment 4 weeks prior to or after surgery.
- 6. DO NOT wear jewelry, contacts, lotion, powder or make-up (including eye make-up, false eyelashes, lipstick) on the day of surgery.
- 7. DO NOT wear tight-fitting clothes on the day of surgery. (Dress in loose, comfortable clothes that open in front and low-heeled shoes.)
- 8. DO NOT plan on leaving town on a trip or vacation 2 weeks prior to surgery or 4 weeks after surgery.
- 9. Do not stop taking your blood pressure medicine.
- 10. Do not drive after surgery until released to do so.
